seniors. The program helps to prevent hunger among our elderly neighbors and improves their ability to remain healthy and independent in their own homes.


Love and support flourish here: Grace Place Alzheimer's Centers are San Antonio's only nonprofit, licensed adult day care locations exclusively for seniors living with
